- 1. SHUT OFF ELECTRICAL SUPPLY FROM THE MAIN FUSE BOX/ CIRCUIT BREAKER
- 2. Remove all parts from carton. Do not throw away any parts.
- 3. Remove canopy screws (E) from canopy (D). Remove mounting plate (B) from canopy (D).
- 4. Guide wires from "J BOX" through center hole in mounting plate (B). Affix mounting plate (B) to "J BOX" using mounting screws (C) provided. Guide wiring through center hole in canopy (D).
- 5. Pulling up on wire firmly, thread socket arm (O) into opening in bottom of lantern canopy (H).
- 6. Make proper electrical connection. Attach ground fixture wire (GREEN) to either the ground screw on mounting plate (B) or to the ground wire in the wall outlet box (usually GREEN or COPPER in color). If attaching to ground wire in outlet box, fasten together with a plastic wire nut (A) and tightly wrap with electrical tape. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THE OUTLET BOX IN YOUR HOME BE PROPERLY GROUNDED.
- 7. Connect the neutral (WHITE or RIBBED BLACK) fixture wire to the neutral (usually WHITE) wire from the outlet box. Fasten wires together with a plastic wire nut (A) and tightly wrap connector with electrical tape.
- Connect the hot (BLACK or SMOOTH BLACK) fixture wire to the hot (BLACK) wire from the outlet box. Fasten wires together with a plastic wire nut (A) and tightly wrap connector with electrical tape.
- 9. Align screw holes in canopy (D) with holes in mounting plate (B). Holding canopy over mounting plate (B), thread canopy screw (E) into canopy (D) and mounting plate (B) to secure fixture to "J BOX."
- 10. Carefully slide shade glass (I) down into slots in exterior shade frame (L).
- Hook extension arm (G) onto exterior shade hook (J). Guide hook end of extension arm (G) into square loop (F). Repeat step for each extension arm (I).
- 12. Install (3) type B 40 watt maximum B10 Candelabra base bulbs into sockets.
- 13. Align holes in exterior shade frame (L) with holes in tabs on lantern canopy (J) and insert exterior shade frame screws (K) to secure shade to fixture.
- Insert interior shade (N) into exterior shade. Align interior shade screws (M) with channels in lantern canopy (H). Turn until interior shade screws (M) are resting securely in channels of lantern canopy (H).

- 11. Carefully slide shade glass (I) down into slots in exterior shade frame (L).
- 12. Align holes in exterior shade frame (L) with holes in tabs on lantern canopy (J) and insert exterior shade frame screws (K) to secure shade to fixture.

 13. Insert interior shade (N) into exterior shade. Align interior shade screws (M) with channels in lantern canopy (H). Turn until interior shade screws (M) are resting securely in channels of lantern canopy (H).
