

WE RECOMMEND INSTALLATION BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

These instructions are provided for your safety. It is very important that they are read completely before beginning the installation of your fixture.

This lamp is equipped with a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). If the plug does not fit securely into the outlet, do not force it - contact a professional electrician. Use the plug with an extension cord only if it can be fully inserted into the cord's socket. Never alter the plug in any way.

This fixture has been rated for up to one (1) 60-watt maximum Type A medium base bulb or one (1) 8.8-watt LED medium base bulb (included). To avoid risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

WARNINGS:

All wires are connected. When unpacking, be careful not to pull wires as a bad connection may result. Do not connect electricity until your fixture is fully assembled. To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock or personal injury, always turn off fixture and allow it to cool prior to replacing the lightbulb. Do not touch bulb when fixture is turned on or look directly at lit bulb. Keep flammable materials away from the lit bulb.

This lighting fixture contains lead, a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects and other reproductive harm. Wash hands after installing, handling, cleaning, or otherwise touching this light fixture.

Keep cord at least 3 ft away from cribs, bassinets and toddler beds. Keep out of reach of children under 3.

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION:

- 1. REMOVE ALL PARTS CAREFULLY FROM THE CARTON AND LAY FLAT ON A SOFT NONABRASIVE SURFACE.
- 2. Slide base cover (F) over loader (G).
- 3. Hold base (F) and loader (G) together and tilt to the side.
- 4. Remove slack from wiring between base swivel (D) and base (F). Holding base swivel (D), slide threaded tube (E) through center hole of base (F) and loader (G). To avoid damaging base (F), do not rotate base swivel (D) while resting on base (F). Make sure base swivel (D) is sitting flush against base (F). NOTE: Pull cord taut when adjusting parts to avoid damaging the cord.
- 5. Slide washer (H) up wiring and onto threaded tube (E). Slide nut (I) up wiring and thread onto threaded tube (E). Tighten nut (I) with wrench (J) provided. CAUTION: Make sure base swivel (D) is sitting flush against base (F) before tightening.
- 6. Place assembled base on level surface.
- Loosen adjustment keys (C) (three each). Rotate swivels (B) (three each) to desired position. Tighten adjustment keys (C) (three each) to secure position of lamp. NOTE: FOR BEST RESULTS, POSITION ARMS OF LAMP AS IN ILLUSTRATION (LEFT).
- 8. Install one (1) 60-watt maximum Type A medium base bulb or one (1) 8.8W LED medium base bulb (included) into socket.
- Remove plug cover (L) from polarized plug (K). Plug bulb into wall outlet.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Wipe clean with a soft, dry cloth or static duster. Always avoid the use of harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners as they may cause damage to the fixture's finish.
