


- Attach Cord Cover (K) into top opening of Cord Cover (L) by turning Cord Cover (K) in counter-clockwise direction. Attach Cord Cover (H) into top opening of Cord Cover (J) by turning Cord Cover (H) in counter-clockwise direction. Attach Cord Cover (G) into top opening of Cord Cover (H) by turning Cord Cover (G) in counter-clockwise direction.
- Attach Cord Cover (G) with whole assembly base into bottom of Mounting Loop (E)
- Unscrew Canopy Ring (F) and slip Canopy Ring (F) and Canopy (D) onto cord cover.
- Attach Mounting Strap (A) to ceiling outlet box with Mounting Screws (C) and insert top Thread Nipple (B) in Mounting Strap (A).
- 7. Attach Mounting Loop (E) to Threaded Nipple (B) and tighten the set screw.
- Attach fixture grounding (GREEN) and house grounding wire to back plate with the green screw. Connect fixture to corresponding house wire with a wire nut. Carefully tuck the wires back into the outlet box. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THE OUTLET BOX IN YOUR HOME BE PROPERLY GROUNDED.



- Slip Canopy Ring (F) and Canopy (D) over the threaded section of Mounting Loop (E). Open the end link of the mounting loop of Cord Cover (G) and lift the fixture base to attach to the Mounting Loop (E) and secure the link.
- Attach Mounting Strap (A) to mounting outlet box with Mounting Screws (B) and insert top Threaded Nipple (C) in Mounting Strap (A).
- Attach Mounting Loop (E) to Threaded Nipple (C) and tighten the set screw.
- Attach fixture grounding (GREEN) and house grounding wire to back plate with the green screw. Connect fixture to corresponding house wire with a wire nut. Carefully tuck the wires back into the outlet box. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THE OUTLET BOX IN YOUR HOME BE PROPERLY GROUNDED.




