

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION:

- 1. Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all plastic covering.
- 2. Turn OFF power to the junction box where the ceiling light will be installed.
- 3. Loosen the screw cap (C3) from canopy (C2) and remove the ceiling plate (C1) from canopy (C2).
- 4. Attach the mounting hardware (C1) to the ceiling with mounting screws (B).
- Assemble the hanging rod A (D3) or B (D4) to hang straight (D2), and tighten the bolts (I1) on hang straight (D2), and hang rods A (D3) and B (D4).

Note: The hanging height is adjustable by using hanging rod B (D4) only, or using 1 or 2 hanging rod A (D3) and B (D4) together.

- 6. Loosen the strain relief device and thread the main cable into it and canopy.
- 7. Connect the ground wire from the fixture to the ground junction box wire (A) (usually the green or bare wire) with a wire nut (E) and wrap the connection with electrical tape. Connect the hot wire to the hot junction box wire (A) (usually black or smooth) with a plastic wire nut (E) and wrap the connection with electrical tape. Connect the neutral wire to the neutral junction box wire (A) (usually white or ribbed) with a plastic wire nut (E) and wrap the connection with electrical tape.
- 8. Move the ceiling box (C2) up to the ceiling, then fasten the screw caps (C3).
- 9. Attach hang straight (D2) to mounting hardware (C1) with quick link (D1).
- 10. Fasten light bulbs (F) to the lamp holders.
- 11. Hang the glass drop (G1) & (G2) from inner layer to outer onto body (H) as drawing on left. For Layer 1, 2 & 3, hang the glass drop (G2) from the top of body (H). For Layer 5, 6 & 7, hang the glass drops (G2) from the bottom of body (H). Then hang glass drop (G1) to Layer 4.

Note: To ensure safety of chandelier during glass installation, please maintain level of chandelier by ensuring you install glass drops in balanced way on opposite ends of light.

12. Restore power to the junction box and test ceiling light fixture.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Make sure that the power is turned off and bulb has cooled before handling.
- Wipe clean with a dry cloth / mild soapy solution. Do not use corrosive cleaners.
- 3. The cable / cord of this ceiling light cannot be replaced; if the cable is damaged, do not use the light.
