## ASSEMBLY \& INSTALLATION:

(Professional installation recommended with at least 2-3 persons for installation.)

1. Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove plastic covering.
2. Turn OFF power to the junction box where the lamp will be installed.
3. Connect the hot wire to the hot junction box wire (usually black or smooth)
with a plastic wire connector (I) and wrap the connection with electrical tape. Connect the neutral wire to the neutral junction box wire (usually white or ribbed) with a plastic wire connector (I) and wrap the connection with electrical tape.
4. Attach the ground wire from the fixture to the ground junction box wire from the outlet box (usually green or bare wire). Or wrap the ground wire around the green ground screw (B).
5. Attach mounting plate (A) to the outlet box using the mounting screws $(\mathrm{C})$ to tighten.
6. Attach the canopy (D) to the mounting plate (A), using the M5 canopy screw (E) and Allen wrench (K) to secure.
7. Insert the bulbs (G) into the sockets (J). Then cover the bulbs with the glass sleeves (F).
8. Restore power to the junction box and test fixture.
9. Installation is complete.

## CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Wipe clean with soft dry cloth. Do not use polishes or cleaners, as it may damage the finish.
