

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

WE RECOMMEND INSTALLATION BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN.

This fixture has been rated for up to two (2) 60-watt maximum Type B TORPEDO light bulbs (not included). To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

WARNINGS:

- 1. All wires are connected.
- 2. Do not remove the lamp from its packaging by pulling on the power cord, as a bad connection may result.
- 3. Do not connect electricity until your lamp is fully assembled.
- 4. To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off and unplug lamp and allow it to cool prior to replacing light bulb.
- 5. Do not touch bulb when fixture is turned on or look directly at lit bulb.
- 6. Keep flammable materials away from lit bulb.
- 7. This lighting fixture contains lead, a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects and other reproductive harm. Wash hands after installing, handling, cleaning or otherwise touching this light fixture.

TO ASSEMBLE:

- 1. Carefully remove all parts from the box.
- 2. Remove mounting plate (A) from fixture base (C) by unscrewing cap nuts (D).
- 3. Affix mounting plate (A) onto ceiling outlet box and secure with mounting screws (B) provided.
- 4. Gently pull the wires from the ceiling outlet and allow the wires to hang. Thread the wires through the center hole in mounting plate (A).
- Connect both hot wires from the fixture (BLACK) to the hot wire from ceiling outlet box (usually BLACK). Fasten them together with a plastic wire connector provided and wrap connection with electrical tape.
- 6. Repeat this procedure for the WHITE neutral wires from the light fixture to the wire from ceiling outlet box (usually WHITE).
- 7. Connect ground wire from the light fixture (bare copper) to ground wire from ceiling outlet box (usually green or copper in color).
- 8. Attach fixture base (C) to affixed mounting plate (A), letting rods on mounting plate (A) pass through the holes on fixture base (C) and secure with cap nuts (D).
- 9. Insert the recommended bulbs into the sockets.
- 10. Loosen base screws (E) from fixture base (C).
- 11. Attach fixture body (F) to fixture base (C) and secure with base screws (E).
- 12. Restore power to outlet box and check operation of fixture.
- 13. Assembly is complete.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Avoid the use of all polishers, cleaners, and abrasives, as they will damage the finish of your lamp. To remove dust or fingerprints, wipe gently with a soft, clean cloth.
