- These instructions are provided for your safety. It is very important that they are properly read **completely** before beginning the installation of your fixture.

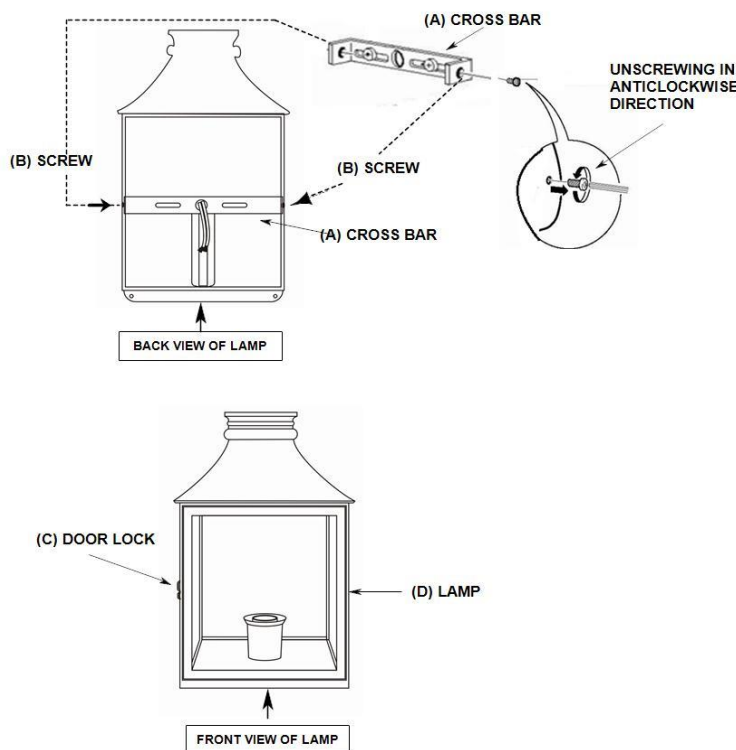
DIRECT WIRE FIXTURE.

WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND INSTALLATION BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN.

WARNINGS :

Turn off power before replacing the bulb, making sure, the bulb had sufficient time to cool down. DO NOT subject the lamp to any shock while lit as shattering of lamp may result.

Vintage French Gas Lantern Sconce



TO ASSEMBLE:

1. Shut off electrical supply at main fuse box / circuit breaker.
2. Remove all parts from carton. Do not throw away any parts.
3. Remove the **Cross Bar (A)** from Lamp by unscrewing the **Screws (B)** as shown in the picture.
4. Affix the **Cross Bar (A)** directly to the **Junction Box** using screws provided.
5. Connect the wires from the sconce to the wires in the junction box, grounding wire (un-laminated) to ground wire in junction box, neutral to neutral, live wire to live wire with plastic wire connectors (not provided) and wrap the wire connector with electrical insulation tape.
6. Place the **Lamp (D)** over the **Crossbar (A)** and tighten the **Screws (B)**.
7. Open the **Door Lock (C)** and insert a Type A bulb (not included) into Threaded Socket.
8. Installation is complete.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

To clean, use a soft cloth only. Do not use any chemical or abrasive cleaners.
