

1. Risk of explosion

- In case of an emergency use a CO2 extinguisher or baking soda to extinguish the fire.


2. Read entire label and instructions before using gel fuel.

- 3. Keep away from children and pets. Unit is not to be operated by children.
- 4. Never leave a burning fire unattended, especially around children or pets.
- 5. When operating unit be sure that the material surrounding the fireplace is non-combustible and it is clear and free of all flammable materials.
- 6. Never touch unit during or after burning gel fuel. Base and glass surround may be extremely HOT. Allow base, glass and gel fuel cans to cool for 20 minutes before touching.
- 7. Make sure unit and gel fuel are burned on a flat and level surface. Avoid locations where it can be knocked over as contents may pour out.
- 8. Do not alter unit in any matter.
- 9. Do not wear flammable or loose clothing when using the unit.
- 10. Do not attempt to move or store the unit until 20 minutes after gel fuel has been extinguished.
- 11. Do not lean over unit when lighting or when in use.
- 12. Do not burn gel fuel outside designated burn area.
- 13. If above warnings are not followed correctly death, serious injury or property damage may result.

Using your Fire Column


- Unit can be used indoors or outdoors. There is no need for ventilaton.
- Use extreme caution while burning. Some surfaces become extremely hot during use.
- Follow all instructions included with gel fuel before use.
- Before using unit, be sure you have read and understood the step-by-step instructions.
- During the initial burn you may experience a slight odor. Odor is temporary and will be absent on following burns. Rev. 112206



Step One

Place the Modesto Column (1) upside down on a level surface.

After unscrewing the three screws to remove base plate, fill the column with 30 Lbs. of sand (Not Included).






Step Three

After sand has been poured into the column, install the Base Plate (3) onto the bottom of the unit using the included hardware as shown.

Flip the column over so that it is upright as shown below.


Install the Glass (2) on the column so that it fits inside the outer rim.

Place the river rock (5) around the can recess. Any rocks that fall in the recess must be removed prior to placing the can into the recess.



Fuel Use - Option 1 Preferred Method

After removing paper label from Real Flame[®] Gel Fireplace Fuel can (sold separately), remove lid and place open can into the center recess. Set the lid aside.




Fuel Use - Option 2

A burn cup is included for use with pourable gel fuel (sold separately). Place the burn cup into the recess in the center of the column. Fill the burn cup with gel fuel until it is approximately 1/2" below the rim of the cup. DO NOT overfill and cleanup an spills prior to lighting.



- Place the round end of the snuffer (4) over the opening on the gel can. Hold in place for 5-10 seconds until flame is extinguished.

-Allow to cool for at least 20 minutes before attempting to replace can lid. CAN WILL BE EXTREMELY HOT

Care and Cleaning

Real Flame Gel Fireplace Fuel cans are for single use only. Allow to cool for at least 20 minutes after use and then discard. Remember to recycle.

A standard household glass cleaner can be used to clean the glass parts of the fireplace.


A damp rag and mild soap can be used to clean the body of the fireplace.

To Clean Burn Cup Burn cup should be cleaned every two burns. This can be cleaned

Burn cup should be cleaned every two burns. This can be cleaned with the snuffer tool included.

- Allow can to cool completely before attempting to clean. Please wait a minimum of 20 minutes after burning before attempting to clean.

- Place the straight edge of the snuffer into the cup and pull along the edge. Residue should be thrown away in the trash.
