

- (D) Wrench (1)
- (E) Glass Tube (1)
- (F) Light Bulb (1)
- (G) CFL Bulb (1)



IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

For safety purposes, this lamp is equipped with a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). If the plug does not fit securely into outlet, do not force it - contact a professional electrician. Use the plug with an extension cord only if it can be fully inserted into the cord's socket. Never alter the plug in any way.

This fixture has been rated for one (1) 40-watt maximum TYPE T3 bulb (F) (included) OR one (1) 9-watt compact fluorescent bulb (G) (included). To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

WARNING

Lighted lamp is HOT!

This lighting fixture contains lead, a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects and other reproductive harm. Wash hands after installing, handling, cleaning or otherwise touching this light fixture.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Turn off/ unplug and allow to cool before replacing bulb (lamp).
- 2. Bulb (lamp) gets HOT quickly! Only contact switch/plug when turning on.
- 3. Do not touch hot lens.
- 4. Do not remain in light if skin feels warm.
- 5. Do not look directly at lighted lamp.
- 6. Keep lamp away from materials that may burn.
- 7. Use only with a 35 watt or smaller bulb (lamp).
- 8. Do not touch the bulb (lamp) at any time. Use a soft cloth. Oil from skin may damage bulb (lamp).

TO ASSEMBLE

- 1. Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all plastic covering.
- 2. Remove Socket Ring (C) from Socket (A).
- 3. Place Shade (B) onto the threaded section of Socket (A) and secure with Socket Ring (C). Tighten with Wrench (D).
- 4. Two options to install the light bulbs.
 - Option A: 1. Insert the recommended bulb (F) into threaded socket.
 - 2. Thread Glass Tube (E) onto threaded Socket (A).
 - Option B: 1. Insert CFL Bulb (G) into the threaded socket. DO NOT USE GLASS TUBE (E).
- 5. Plug into proper electrical outlet and test fixture.
- 6. Assembly is complete.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Avoid the use of all polishers, cleaners, and abrasives, as they will damage the finish of your lamp. To remove dust or fingerprints, wipe gently with a soft, clean cloth.
