
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





















ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

<u>STEP 1:</u> Place cabinet assembly top down as shown. Use a protective material between the cabinet and floor to prevent any damage.




<u>STEP 2:</u> Place four leg post assemblies in place as shown. Be sure the threaded tee-nut in the leg post is facing toward the outer corner of the cabinet.





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS CONTINUED:

STEP 3: Fasten each leg post securely in place using the 3/8" Bolt, 3/8" Lock Washer, and 3/8" Flat Washer as shown.




<u>STEP 4:</u> The unit is now ready to flip over and placed in the desired location. Two people minimum are required and care should be taken to insure no damage occures to unit or flooring.






ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS CONTINUED:

STEP 5: Attach the adhesive backed felt pads to the bottom surface of each goalie mallet.



<u>STEP 6:</u> You are now ready to plug the unit into an electrical outlet. Once this has been completed, locate the power on/off rocker switch and turn the unit on. Play may begin, enjoy!





BASIC RULES OF PLAY:

The object of the game is to score goals while preventing your opponent from doing the same. The person who scores ten(10) goals is the winner.

Starting player in all games is decided by a coin flip. Play begins with the starting player striking the puck towards the opponent's goal from any position behind the center line. Following a goal, the puck is put back into play by the person scored upon.

In the event a player strikes the puck and the puck leaves the play surface, that player's opponent is allowed a penalty shot. The goal is to be unprotected and the shot must be "banked" off a side rail from either of the two "face-off" circles.

At no time, while the puck is in play, is a player allowed to touch the puck with a hand or trap the puck with the goalie mallet. The goalie mallet must always remain in contact with the playing surface and the player must have one foot on the floor at all times.

PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE/CLEANING:

To keep the playing surface clean, vacuum as needed. Turn the table on and vacuum with a soft brush head and wipe with a soft, dry cloth.

If soil marks cannot be removed, use an application of window cleaner, also with the unit turned on.

The pucks can be sanded smooth in the event they no longer float across the surface properly. Place the puck on a sheet of 220 grit sandpaper and move back and forth until any burrs or damaged edges are removed.
