
AXIS 3-TIER CHANDELIER 48"





AXIS 3-TIER CHANDELIER 48"


SAFETY CABLE ASSSEMBLY



1. Remove the connector screws (U) from steel wire connector (V).



2. Pull the steel wire (W) to slide through one hole of the steel wire connector (V) and side hole of the ceiling plate (S). Then connect to the other hole of the steel wire connector (V).



3. Using two connector screws (U), secure the steel wire connector (V) tightly based on desired hanging height.

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION:

(PROFESSIONAL INSTALLATION RECOMMENDED, OR AT LEAST 3-4 PERSONS TO FINISH THE INSTALLATION.)

- 1. Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove plastic covering.
- 2. Turn OFF power to the junction box where the lamp will be installed.
- 3. Connect the rod (I) to the wire housing hook (H) and medium ring hook (J). There are three rod pieces (I) that need to be connected.
- 4. Connect the rod (O) to the wire housing hook (H) and center ring hook (P). There are three rod pieces (O) that need to be connected.
- 5. Connect the rod (K) to the medium ring hook (J) and large ring hook (L). There are three rod pieces that need to be connected.
- 6. Connect the rod (Q) to the center ring hook (P) and small ring hook (M). There are three rod pieces (Q) that need to be connected.
- 7. If more length is desired, choose different lengths of extension rod (F) to connect onto wire housing outer rod (G). Then connect the other end of F onto connector (C). If extension rods are not needed, directly screw the connector (C) onto the wire housing outer rod (G). You can loosen or tighten all the M4 small set screws attached on the extension rods (F) and wire housing outer rod (G). It is recommended to retighten all the M4 set screws once all extension rods are assembled to make sure the whole fixture is secure.
- 8. Connect the canopy ring (E) and canopy (D) onto the connector (C).
- 9. Drill two holes in the ceiling that align with the holes on the mounting plate (A), and insert M6 ceiling anchors (Z). Then screw two M6 round head wood screws (B) into anchors. If desired, you can use two G1/4-20T round head screws (B) to fix the mounting plate (A) onto the outlet box.
- 10. Drill four holes in the ceiling that align with the holes on the ceiling plate (S) and insert M4 ceiling anchors (R).
- 11. Screw four ceiling screws (T) into anchors.
- 12. Pull the steel wire (W) to slide through one hole of the steel wire connector (V) and side hole of the ceiling plate (S). Then connect to the other hole of the steel wire connector (V). Using two connector screws (U), secure steel wire connector (V) tightly based on desired hanging height. (Please refer to the detailed illustration on Page 2 for the steel wire assembly.)
- 13. Connect the hot wire to the hot junction box wire (usually black or smooth) with a plastic wire connector (X) and wrap the connection with electrical tape. Connect the neutral wire to the neutral junction box wire (usually white or ribbed) with a plastic wire connector (X) and wrap the connection with electrical tape.

ASSEMBLY & INSTRUCTION CONT:

- 14. Attach the ground wire from the fixture to the ground junction box wire from the outlet box (usually green or bare wire) or wrap the ground wire around the green ground screw (Y).
- 15. Slide up the canopy ring (E) to rest underneath the canopy. Then tightly screw to hold the canopy against the ceiling.
- 16. Insert the 51 T30 bulbs into the thread sockets.
- 17. If desired, tighten the cable and tube with a tie.
- 18. Restore power to the junction box and test fixture.
- 19. Installation is complete.
