

## SHUT OFF THE MAIN ELECTRICAL SUPPLY FROM THE FUSE BOX OR CIRCUIT BREAKER PANEL.

- 1. Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all plastic coverings.
- 2. Determine the desired hanging length of the pendant. Attach the extension rods (C) (D) (E) according to the height needed.
- 3. Pass the wire through the connecting rods until it comes out through the back of the canopy (B).
- 4. Attach the mounting plate (A) to the ceiling and secure it with mounting screws and a suitable fastener from your local hardware store.
- 5. Attach nipple (G) to mounting plate (A).
- 6. Hook the carabiner (F) onto the connecting rods (C) (D) (E) and the canopy loop (B).
- Carefully inspect the pendant's two attachment wires. One has very fine edges molded into the plastic coating - this is the NEUTRAL wire. The coating of the second wire is smooth - this is the HOT wire. The bare wire is the ground wire.
- Connect the ground wire from the fixture to the ground wire (usually bare) from your ceiling box using a wire nut. If your home does not have a ground wire, attach the ground wire from the fixture to the green ground screw inside the outlet box. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THE OUTLET BOX IN YOUR HOME IS PROPERLY GROUNDED.
- 9. Connect the NEUTRAL wire from your pendant with the neutral wire (usually white) from your ceiling box using a wire nut.
- Connect the HOT wire from the fixture to the hot (usually black) wire from your outlet box using a wire nut. DO NOT REVERSE HOT AND NEUTURAL CONNECTIONS OR SAFETY WILL BE COMPROMISED.




