

# IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

For safety purposes, this lamp is equipped with a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). If the plug does not fit securely into your outlet, do not force it - contact a professional electrician. Use the plug with an extension cord only if it can be fully inserted into the cord's socket. Never alter the plug in any way.

This fixture has been rated for up to (1) 100-watt maximum Type A bulb, or 9W maximum LED bulb. To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

All wires are connected. When unpacking, be careful not to pull wires, as a bad connection may result. Do not connect electricity until your fixture is fully assembled. To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off fixture and allow it to cool prior to replacing the light bulb. Do not touch or look directly at the bulb when fixture is illuminated. Keep flammable materials away from lit bulb.

## ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION

- Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all plastic coverings.
- 2. Insert Harp (D) into the Saddle (B).
- 3. Unscrew the Finial (E) from the Harp (D) and place the desired shade, (sold separately).
- 4. Attach the Finial (E) and tighten to secure the shade.
- 5. Insert the 9-watt LED bulb (included) into threaded socket.

- 6. Plug into proper electrical outlet and test fixture.
- 7. Assembly is complete.

## CAREINSTRUCTIONS

Do not use polishes or cleaners on the fixture. Wipe clean with a soft, dry cloth.
