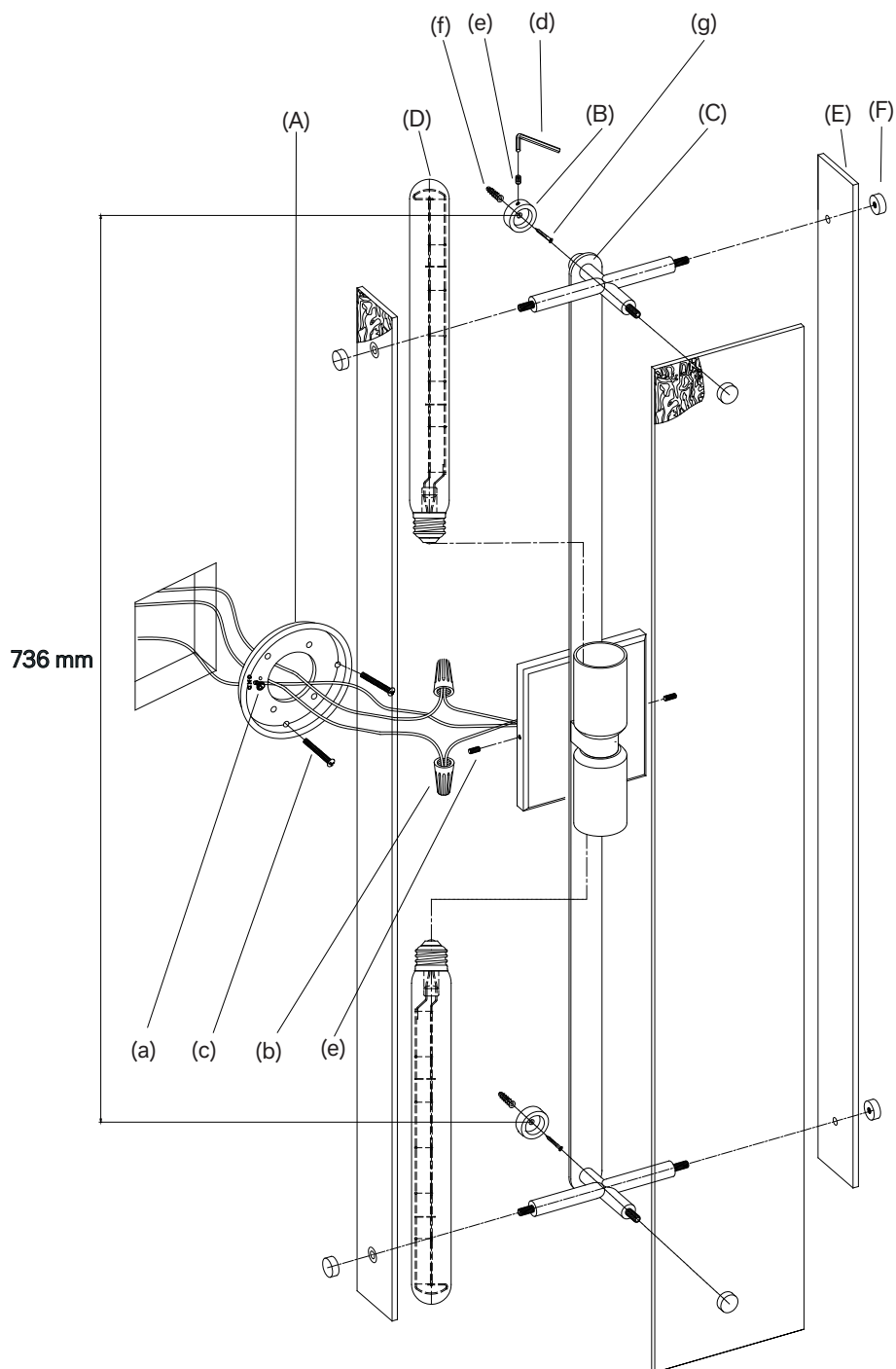


PARTS ENCLOSED

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

INSTALLATION BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.

This fixture has been rated for up to two (2) 40-watt-maximum Type T bulbs or 4-watt-maximum LED bulbs. To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage. When checking the circuit connection, you need to remove the diffusers first.

WARNINGS

All wires are connected. When unpacking, be careful not to pull wires, as a bad connection may result. Do not connect electricity until your fixture is fully assembled. To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off fixture and allow it to cool prior to replacing the lightbulbs. Do not touch or look directly at the bulb when fixture is illuminated. Keep flammable materials away from lit bulbs.

WARNING: STRANGULATION HAZARD

Keep cord at least 3 feet away from cribs, bassinets, and toddler beds. Keep out of reach of children under 3 years of age.

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION

SHUT OFF THE MAIN ELECTRICAL SUPPLY FROM THE FUSE BOX OR CIRCUIT BREAKER PANEL.

1. Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all plastic coverings.
2. Attach the ground wire from the fixture to the ground junction box wire from the outlet box (usually green or bare wire). Or wrap the fixture's ground wire around the Green Ground Screw (a) and affix the green ground screw to the Mounting Plate (A).
3. Connect the hot wire to the hot junction box wire (usually black or smooth) with a Plastic Wire Connector (b) and wrap the connection with electrical tape. Connect the neutral wire to the neutral junction box wire (usually white or ribbed) with a Plastic Wire Connector (b) and wrap the connection with electrical tape.
4. Mark the location of two small mounting plate holes on the wall. Using a pencil, mark two holes on the wall 736 mm apart. These are for the Small Mounting Plates (B). Using the marks as a guide, drill holes for the Wall Anchors (f). Insert the Wall Anchors into the holes and hammer until flush with the wall.

5. Attach two Small Mounting Plates (B) to the wall using the Anchor Screws (g). Tighten with a screwdriver.
6. Attach the Mounting Plate (A) to the outlet box using the Mounting Screws (c). Tighten with a screwdriver.
7. Attach the Back Plate (C) to the Mounting Plate (A) and Small Mounting Plates (B) using the Allen Wrench (d) and Plate Screws (e). Fully tighten.
8. Insert the Bulbs (D) into the threaded sockets.
9. Attach the Diffusers (E) to the Back Plate (C) and fully tighten using the Finials (F).
10. Restore power to the junction box and test the light by turning it on.
11. Installation is complete.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Do not use polishes or cleaners on the fixture. Wipe clean with a soft, dry cloth.
