### FEATURES

The pairing of antique reclaimed elm doors and cast metal achieves the "form meets function" industrial appeal of Flatiron.

- Reclaimed elm tabletop is hand selected, planed, sanded and unfinished, with the patina of time-worn wood
- Given its previous life as an antique door, tabletop may have holes from hinges or door knob, or remnants of the original hardware
- Nicks, nail marks and imperfections speak of the wood's age and provenance
- Welded, riveted solid steel frame stands on caster wheels and is supported by structural cross bracing
- Base available in Distressed White, Rust or Zinc finish, all available with Reclaimed Natural Elm top; Rust base also available with Espresso Elm top

- By its nature, unsealed salvaged wood may be somewhat uneven, and may cup or bow slightly over time, further enhancing the rustic one-of-a-kind character; cracks may be present

- This item is artisan crafted with meticulous care. Given its handmade and hand-finished nature, variations in the wood or metal work are to be expected and celebrated. No two items are exactly alike.

### CARE

Clear furniture wax can be applied to protect the finish from minor spills. Use coasters or placemats to help prevent marks or stains. Avoid mineral oil, as its usage could discolor the wood. Wipe the table clean with a soft, dry cloth after each use.

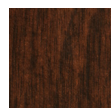
