



CHARACTERISTICS OF MARBLE

- Each 1¼"-thick slab of marble is honed and finished by hand and sealed twice for longevity
- Distinctive veins, markings and color variations are unique to each piece

CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF MARBLE

- Although all of our marble tops are sealed before shipping, they are still porous by nature and can be stained, scratched or chipped.
- Always blot spills immediately and rinse with a clean, damp cloth
- Do not place hot items directly on the marble.
- To prevent ring marks, dry immediately.
- Place mats beneath hard objects that might scratch the surface.
- Dust frequently with a clean, soft cloth.
- Wash periodically with a cloth dampened with warm water and if necessary, a small amount of mild dishwashing liquid or stone soap. Use a second damp cloth to thoroughly remove the soap. Dry with a soft cloth.
- Do not use chemical cleansers, sprays, abrasive cleaners, or products that contain lemon, vinegar or other acids.
- Marble should be resealed every 2 years to prevent staining.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF CAESARSTONE® & VIATERA®

- Due to the materials' high density, non-porous qualities and scratch resistance, regular cleaning with a damp cloth and soap or mild detergent is all that's needed.
- Note that Caesarstone's unique concrete finishes may show smudges, fingerprints and other signs of daily living. Wipe clean with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Blot common household spills like liquid droplets and rings immediately.
- A solution of 50% vinegar and 50% water is also safe and effective.
- Thoroughly rinse with hot water after use and dry with a soft cloth or paper towel.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- Avoid exposure to chemicals, as this could cause permanent damage or discoloration. Should the surface accidentally be exposed to potentially damaging products, rinse immediately with water to neutralize the effect.
