

# CHARACTERISTICS OF MARBLE

- Each 11/4"-thick slab of marble is honed and finished by hand and sealed twice for longevity.
- Distinctive veins, markings and color variations are unique to each piece.

### CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF MARBLE

- Although all of our marble tops are sealed before shipping, they are still porous by nature and can be stained, scratched or chipped.
- Always blot spills immediately and rinse with a clean, damp cloth.
- Do not place hot items directly on the marble.
- To prevent ring marks, dry immediately.
- Place mats beneath hard objects that might scratch the surface.
- Dust frequently with a clean, soft cloth.
- Wash periodically with a cloth dampened with warm water and if necessary, a small amount of mild dishwashing liquid or stone soap. Use a second damp cloth to thoroughly remove the soap. Dry with a soft cloth.
- Do not use chemical cleansers, sprays, abrasive cleaners, or products that contain lemon, vinegar or other acids.
- Marble should be resealed once a year or as needed to prevent staining.

## CHARACTERISTICS OF TRAVERTINE

- Each 11/4"-thick slab of vein-cut natural Italian travertine is honed and sealed for a satin finish that reveals the beauty and character of each piece.
- Inherent variations in natural travertine color, texture and veining, as well as variance resulting from the hand finishing process, are to be expected and celebrated. No two items will be exactly alike.

#### CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF TRAVERTINE

- · Wash periodically with a clean, damp cloth. If necessary, a small amount of mild dishwashing liquid may be used.
- Travertine has natural pitting that can collect debris.
- Avoid the use of harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaning materials.
- The use of a resealer, such as More™ Premium Stone Sealer, is recommended. Apply once a year or as needed.
- Protect the surface from acidic substances like wine, coffee, fruit juice and tomato sauce.
- Wipe spills immediately with a soft, dry cloth.
- · As a natural and porous material, travertine can be nicked, stained or scratched; avoid placing sharp or heavy objects on surface.

### CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF CAESARSTONE® & VIATERA®

- Due to the materials' high density, non-porous qualities and scratch resistance, regular cleaning with a damp cloth and soap or mild detergent is all that's needed.
- Note that Caesarstone's unique concrete finishes may show smudges, fingerprints and other signs of daily living. Wipe clean with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Blot common household spills like liquid droplets and rings immediately.
- A solution of 50% vinegar and 50% water is also safe and effective.
- Thoroughly rinse with hot water after use and dry with a soft cloth or paper towel.
- · Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- Avoid exposure to chemicals, as this could cause permanent damage or discoloration. Should the surface accidentally be exposed to potentially damaging
  products, rinse immediately with water to neutralize the effect.
