ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION

SHUT OFF THE MAIN ELECTRICAL SUPPLY FROM THE FUSE BOX OR CIRCUIT BREAKER PANEL.

- Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all plastic coverings.
- Remove Mounting Plate (A) from Canopy (I) by removing Canopy Screws (H).
- Attach Mounting Plate (A) to the ceiling outlet box and secure with Mounting Screws (B) and other proper fasteners from your local hardware store.

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION CONT.

- Feed the safety steel wire and fixture wires through the Connection Rods (K) (L) (M) (N) (O) (P).
- Screw Connection Rods (K) (L) (M) to the middle of Fixture Body (Q) according to the height needed.
- 6. Screw Connection Rods (N) (O) (P) to the Fixture Body (Q) according to the height needed.
- Screw Connector (J) to the top of Connection Rods (K) (L) (M)
 (N) (O) (P).
- 8. Attach Canopy (I) with Metal Plate (G) to the nipple of the Connection Rods (K) (L) (M) (N) (O) (P). Secure Washer (C) and Nut (D) to Connection Rods (K) (L) (M) (N) (O) (P) using 1/4" D Wrench (AA). Secure Washer (E) and Nut (F) to Connector (J) using 1/2" D Wrench (BB). See diagram 1 on previous page.
- Connect the steel safety wire from the fixture and the safety cable from ceiling. Refer to the illustration on previous page.
- 10. Wrap fixture ground wire (bare copper) around the green grounding screw on Mounting Plate (A) and connect to the ground wire (usually green or bare copper) on the outlet box using a wire nut. NOTE: It is imperative that the fixture is grounded.
- 11. Connect fixture neutral wire (ribbed) to the outlet box neutral wire (usually white) using a wire nut.
- 12. Connect the fixture hot wire (smooth with markings) to the outlet box hot wire (usually black) using a wire nut. CAUTION: Do not reverse the hot and neutral connections.
- 13. Attach Canopy (I) with Fixture Body (Q) to the affixed Mounting Plate (A). Secure with Canopy Screws (H).
- 14. Remove Collar Rings (V) from Caps (R). Affix Outer Glass Shades (U) to Caps (R) and secure with Collar Rings (V).
- 15. Attach Brackets (X) to the top of Socket Covers (T) and secure with Knurled Rings (S).
- Remove Socket Rings (Y) from Socket Covers (T). Affix Inner Glass Shades (W) to Socket Covers (T) and secure with Socket Rings (Y).
- 17. Insert Bulbs (Z) into each of the sockets.
- 18. Restore power to outlet box and check operation of fixture.
- 19. Assembly is complete.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Do not use polishes or cleaners on the fixture. Wipe clean with a soft, dry cloth.
