
RAIN OUTDOOR SCONCE

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

INSTALLATION BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.

This fixture has been rated for one (1) 25-watt maximum Type T lightbulb (included). To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

WARNINGS

All wires are connected. When unpacking, be careful not to pull wires, as a bad connection may result. Do not connect electricity until the fixture is fully assembled. To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off fixture and allow it to cool prior to replacing the lightbulb. Do not touch or look directly at the bulb when fixture is illuminated. Keep flammable materials away from lit bulb.

Keep cord at least 3 feet away from cribs, bassinets, and toddler beds. Keep out of reach of children under 3 years of age.

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION

SHUT OFF THE MAIN ELECTRICAL SUPPLY FROM THE FUSE BOX OR CIRCUIT BREAKER PANEL.

- Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all plastic coverings.
- Remove Mounting Plate (A) from Fixture Base (D) by loosening Set Screws (C) using Screwdriver (E).
- Attach Mounting Plate (A) to the wall outlet box by aligning the holes and secure with Mounting Screws (B).

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION CONT.

- Gently pull the wire from the wall outlet box and allow the wire to hang. Thread the wire through the center hole in Mounting Plate (A).
- 5. Attach the fixture ground wire (green) and house ground wire (usually green or bare) to wall outlet box with the green grounding screw. Connect fixture wires to corresponding house wire with a wire nut. Carefully tuck the wires back into the outlet box. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THE OUTLET BOX IN YOUR HOME IS PROPERLY GROUNDED.
- Connect the neutral wire (white) to the neutral outlet wire (usually white) with a plastic wire connector and wrap the connection with electrical tape.
- Connect the hot wire (black) to the hot outlet box wire (usually black) with a plastic wire connector and wrap the connection with electrical tape. DO NOT REVERSE THE HOT AND NEUTRAL CONNECTIONS OR SAFETY WILL BE COMPROMISED.
- 8. Attach Fixture Base (D) to Mounting Plate (A) and secure with Set Screws (C), then tighten with Screwdriver (E).
- 9. Insert Bulb (G) into the socket.
- 10. Insert the top threaded portion of Glass Shade (H) into Cap (F) and turn in a clockwise direction until snug. Do not overtighten. When replacing Bulb (G), always make sure Glass Shade (H) is securely tightened to Cap (F) for safety. Note: Do not inadvertently loosen Glass Shade (H) from Cap (F) when cleaning or Glass Shade (H) could fall unexpectedly, creating a safety hazard.
- 11. Restore power to outlet box and check operation of fixture.
- 12. Assembly is complete.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Do not use polishes or cleaners on the fixture. Wipe clean with a soft, dry cloth.
