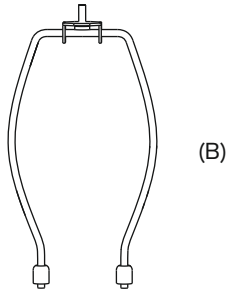
THADDEUS FLOOR LAMP

PARTS ENCLOSED

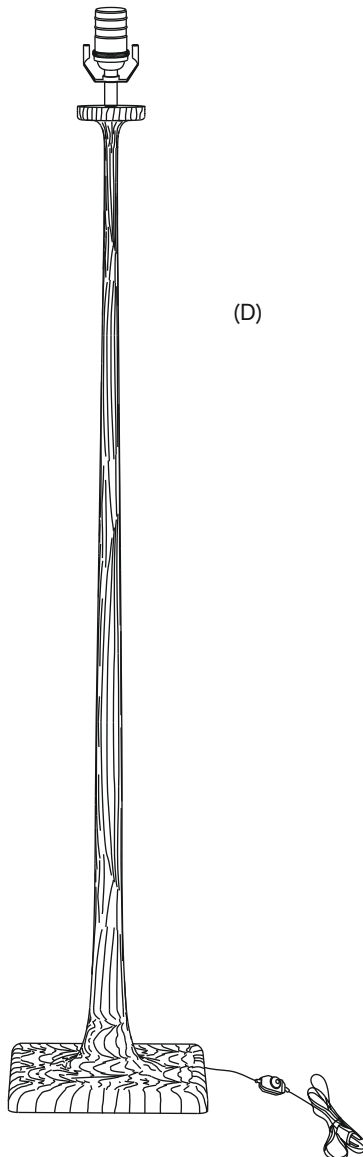
- (A) Finial

THADDEUS FLOOR LAMP

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

For safety purposes, this lamp is equipped with a polarized plug (one blade wider than the other). If the plug does not fit, don't force it; contact a professional electrician. Use the plug with an extension cord only if it can be fully inserted into the cord's socket. Never alter the plug in any way. This lamp has been rated up to one (1) 9-watt LED bulb or 60-watt Type A bulb. To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

WARNINGS

1. All wires are connected.
2. Do not remove the lamp from the packaging by pulling on the power cord, as a bad connection may result.
3. Do not connect electricity until your lamp is fully assembled.
4. To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off and unplug lamp and allow it to cool prior to replacing lightbulb.
5. Do not touch the bulb when fixture is turned on or look directly at lit bulb.
6. Keep flammable materials away from lit bulb.

WARNING: STRANGULATION HAZARD

Keep cord at least 3 feet away from cribs, bassinets, and toddler beds. Keep out of reach of children under 3 years of age.

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION

1. Carefully unpack all the contents from the box and remove all coverings.
2. Insert the recommended bulb into the threaded socket.
3. Remove the finial (A) from the harp (B) by unscrewing in a counterclockwise direction.
4. Place the shade (not included) on top of the harp (B) and attach the Harp to the Lamp Body (D).
5. Reattach the finial (A) and secure the shade by tightening in a clockwise direction.
6. Plug into proper outlet and test fixture.
7. Lamp is now ready for use.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Avoid the use of all polishes, cleaners, and abrasives, as they will damage the finish of your lamp. To remove dust or finger prints, wipe gently with a soft, dry cloth.
