

Directional fabrics have a woven pattern or raised pile with a definite direction. These dimensional fabrics can have a different shade or appearance depending on the nap – the direction in which the fibers lie. As a result, these fabrics must be upholstered in one specific direction to maintain visual continuity. Given this directionality, sectional configurations with a 90-degree return will have one section that looks lighter or darker depending on the ambient light.

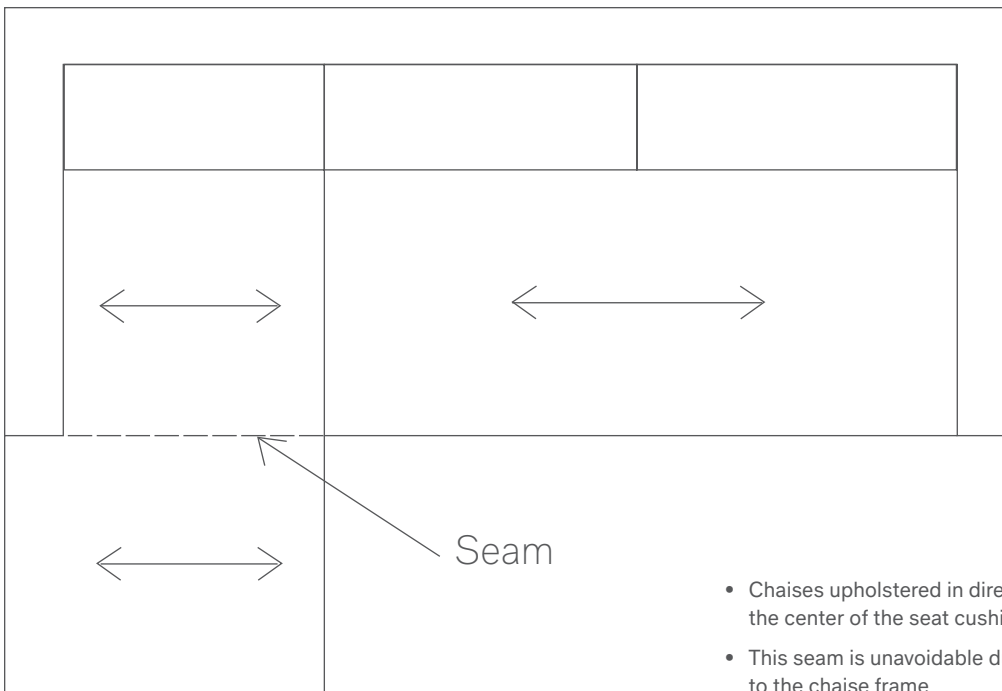
