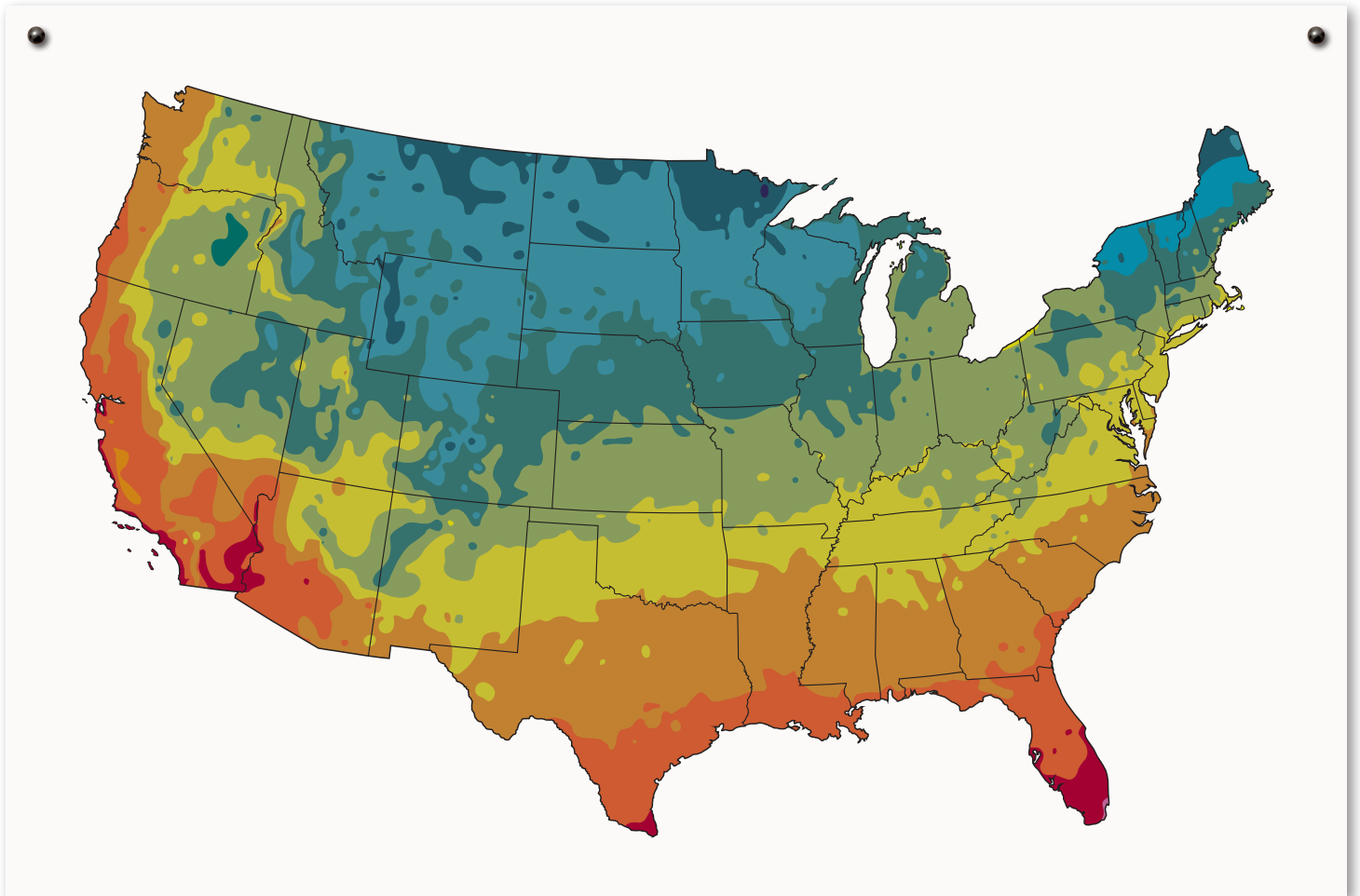


# RESTORATION HARDWARE

## PLANT HARDINESS ZONE MAP



<b>ZONE 2</b> -50 to -40 F (-45.6 to -40 C)	<b>ZONE 7</b> 0 to 10 F (-17.8 to -12.3 C)
<b>ZONE 3</b> -40 to -30 F (-40 to -34.5 C)	<b>ZONE 8</b> 10 to 20 F (-12.3 to -6.6 C)
<b>ZONE 4</b> -30 to -20 F (-43.5 to -28.9 C)	<b>ZONE 9</b> 20 to 30 F (-6.6 to -1.1 C)
<b>ZONE 5</b> -20 to -10 F (-28.9 to -23.3 C)	<b>ZONE 10</b> 30 to 40 F (-1.1 to -4.4 C)
<b>ZONE 6</b> -10 to 0 F (-23.3 to -17.8 C)	<b>ZONE 11</b> 40 F and above (4 C and above)

To see if the plant you would like to purchase is suitable for your climate, find your general location and corresponding zone on this map. Compare your zone to the zone(s) specified on the plant's product page on our website.

If a plant is "hardy" for your region (that is, capable of withstanding the average coldest temperature where you live), the zone specified on our site and on the plant's tag will match yours. Please note that local variations such as soil, moisture, wind and sunlight are also likely to influence a plant's growth. *Some of our plants cannot be shipped to Alaska, Hawaii, Oregon or Canada.*

This map is based on the USDA's Plant Hardiness Zone Map, which divides the US and Canada into 11 hardiness zones; the United States falls within Zones 2 through 10.
