

Rh debuts in Italy. Inside, the restaurant La Volta.



A 19th-century neo-Renaissance building in the heart of Corso Venezia is becoming a new international design hub, complete with a dedicated restaurant space. The American furniture group **Rh** debuted in Italy with **Rh Milan, The Gallery**, a project that combines retail and hospitality in a single immersive experience. Inside, as in most of the brand's locations, there is also a restaurant, which, in the Italian case, is called **La Volta Restaurant & Bar**.

Located in the basement of the building constructed in 1880 by **Giorgio Pellini** (who also designed the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II), the restaurant seats 176 and is managed directly by the group. The menu offers Italian cuisine with pizzas, risottos, fresh pastas, and traditional dishes such as cotoletta alla milanese, alongside Rh's signature international classics. The food offering is completed by the **Rh Bar & Lounge**, located on the top of the building's seven levels.

On the occasion of the opening evening, which took place on Tuesday 21 April during Milan Design Week, the space exceptionally hosted numerous protagonists of the gastronomic scene, from **Da Vittorio** to **Iyo**, up to a pop-up of **Bar Basso**, open throughout the week.
