

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Please find the corresponding numbered parts before you assemble the unit. Place tabletop (A) on a flat floor covered with a protective material to prevent damage to the tabletop.

Place base (B) onto the tabletop; keep tabletop position blocks on the underside of the top between the legs to prevent top from moving horizontally. Secure using screws (1), flat washers (2) and spring washers (3). Place all screws in position first, then tighten with screwdriver.

- 2. Attach furniture bracket (4) to the underside of console top horizontally (see page 2). Secure using screws (7) and tighten with screwdriver. Fix wall bracket (4) to wall vertically. Secure using screws (8) amd tighten with screwdriver. Always locate and attach wall bracket to stud. Do not depend on wall anchors. Secure using lanyard (9), clevis pins (5) and hairpin clips (6) to connect furniture and wall bracket as shown.
- 3. Adjust levelers as necessary.
- 4. Assembly is complete.







HOW TO USE HAIRPIN

To install, push or pull Bow-Tie™ into hole. Pull locked loop up and over to release.




EXAMPLES FOR SECURING
