ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION:

- 1. SHUT OFF THE MAIN ELECTRICAL SUPPLY FROM THE MAIN FUSE BOX/CIRCUIT BREAKER.
- 2. Open glass shade (G) by unthreading thumbscrews (E) and rotating into open position. Do not completely unthread thumb screw from threaded nipple.
- 3. Remove cross bar (A) from canopy (D) by removing decorative nuts (F) from cross bar screws (B). Set decorative nuts (F) aside.
- 4. Affix cross bar (A) to ceiling outlet box with mounting screws (C). Gently pull wires from ceiling outlet box.
- 5. Lift canopy (D) to ceiling outlet box; make proper electrical connection.
- 6. Attach ground wire from fixture (green or copper in color) to ground wire from ceiling outlet box.
- 7. Attach hot wire from fixture (black in color) to hot wire from ceiling outlet box. Fasten wires together with wire nut (H) and tightly wrap connection with electrical tape.
- 8. Attach neutral wire from fixture (white in color) to neutral wire from ceiling outlet box. Fasten wires together with wire nut (H) and tightly wrap connection with electrical tape.
- 9. Gently push wires back into ceiling outlet box.
- 10. Align crossbar screws (A) with holes in top of canopy (D). Place canopy (D) flush against ceiling, allowing crossbar screws (B) to pass through holes in canopy (D). To secure fixture to ceiling, thread decorative nuts (F) onto exposed threads of crossbar screws (B).
- 11. Install two (2) 60-watt maximum TYPE A medium base bulbs or two (2) 7.5-watt LED medium base bulbs into socket.
- 12. Move glass shade (G) into closed position and secure with thumb screws (E).

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Wipe clean with a soft, dry cloth or static duster. Always avoid the use of harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners as they may cause damage to the fixture's finish.
