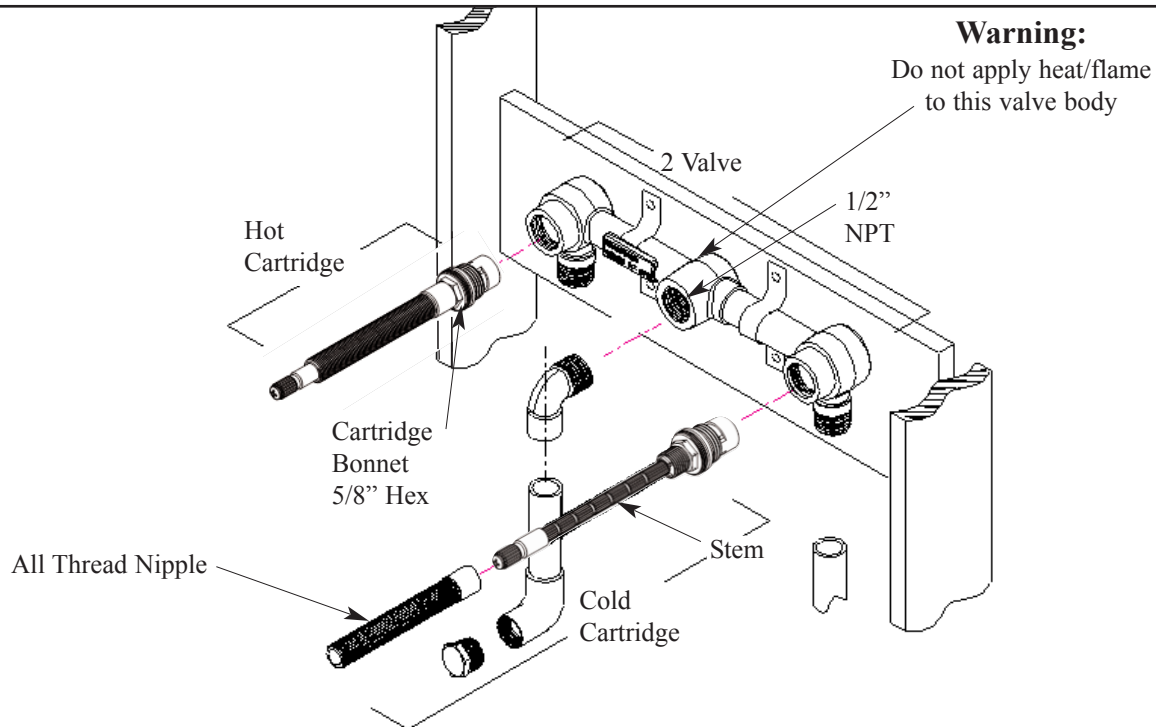
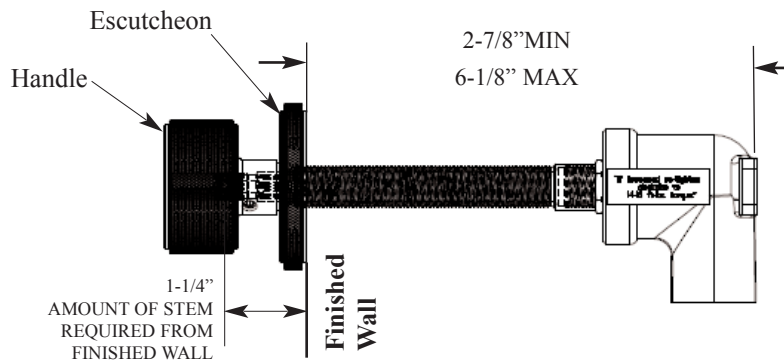
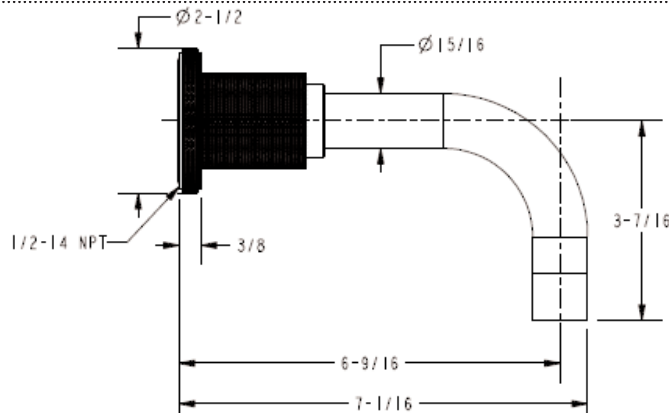

# Restoration Hardware

## Product Size Specification

**Note:** This valve is designed to fit in a 2" X 4" stud wall (or thicker) installation. Use stem extension kit #RH-I-384 (sold separately) if valve installed is too far away from finished wall).



All thread connections are 1/2" NPT

Dimensions are in inches and Approximation of a typical installation

## Recommended Installation by a Professional Plumbing Contractor

**Note:** Use plumber's tape or equivalent to seal all threaded port joints.

**Warning:** To prevent severe damage to valve body, any solder/braze process must be performed a min. of 4" from ports.

- Turn off water to valve.
- Plug the unused ½" NPT outlet, top for tub, bottom for shower, with ½" NPT plug (not included).
- Slide union nuts onto copper supply pipes and solder/braze union tailpieces onto copper supply pipes.
- Tighten union nuts onto valve body. Check the level of valve body assembly.
- Connect end device line to the open ½" NPT outlet port.
- Turn on water supply, pressurize system and check for leaks.
- Trim stem to 1-1/4" from finished wall.
- All-thread needs to be trimmed 3/4" shorter than stem.

**Note:** Do not cut stem and all-thread nipple until finished wall is complete and a dimension check of handle and escutcheons/bonnet trim is done. (Stem is grooved at ½" intervals.)

- Install bushing onto all-thread nipple.
- Insert o-ring into the backside of escutcheon. Place escutcheon over nipple and flush against finished wall.
- Secure handle into place by first engaging stem and then threading onto bushing.

**Note:** To achieve desired handle rotational alignment, the cartridge **MUST** be tightened in a clockwise rotation only. (Cartridge Bonnet factory torque is 14 ft-lbs.)

## Care and Cleaning

The lustrous finish on your Restoration Hardware Bathware fixture should be treated with care. Improper handling or cleaning can damage the surface of any metal finish. Use a soft cloth to wipe clean. Avoid harsh abrasive cleaner. Water contains lime and other mineral deposits that will be left on the surface after the water has evaporated. You can prevent these deposits from forming by always wiping the fixture dry immediately after use.
