

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

WE RECOMMEND INSTALLATION BY A LICENSED ELECTRICIAN.

This fixture has been rated for one (2) 100-watt maximum TYPE A standard bulb (not included) OR 23W Compact Fluorescent bulb (not included). To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.

WARNINGS:

- 1. All wires are connected. Do not remove the lamp from its packaging by pulling on the power cord, as a bad connection may result.
- 2. Do not connect electricity until your lamp is fully assembled.
- 3. To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, or personal injury, always turn off and unplug lamp and allow it to cool prior to replacing light bulb.
- 4. Do not touch bulb when fixture is turned on or look directly at lit bulb.
- 5. Keep flammable materials away from lit bulb.
- 6. This lighting fixture contains lead, a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects and other reproductive harm. Wash hands after installing, handling, cleaning or otherwise touching this light fixture.

TO ASSEMBLE:

- SHUT OFF THE MAIN ELECTRICAL SUPPLY FROM THE MAIN FUSE BOX/CIRCUIT BREAKER!
- 2. Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all plastic covering.
- 3. Attach side opening of shade spider located inside shade (K) to the threaded section on top of socket and tighten with washer (J).
- 4. Hook the chain (G) to top loop (H).
- 5. Feed wire through chain (G), canopy (E) and mounting loop (D).
- 6. Unscrewing canopy ring (F), slide canopy ring (F) and canopy (E) on chain (G).
- 7. Attach mounting strap (A) to ceiling outlet box with mounting screws (C) and insert top thread nipple (B) in mounting strap (A).
- 8. Attach mounting loop (D) to thread nipple (B) and tighten the set screw.
- 9. Attach chain (G) with fixture to chain mounting loop (D) at desired height.
- 10. Gently pull the wiring from the ceiling outlet box and allow the wires to hang. Thread the wires through the center hole in the mounting strap (A).
- 11. Attach the fixture ground wire and house ground wire (usually green) to ceiling outlet box with the green grounding screw. Connect fixtures to corresponding house wire with a wire nut. Carefully tuck the wires back into the outlet box. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THE OUTLET BOX IN YOUR HOME BE PROPERLY GROUNDED.
- 12. Connect the neutral wire (white wire) to the neutral outlet wire (usually white) with a plastic wire connector and wrap the connection with electrical tape.
- 13. Connect the hot wire (black wire) to the hot outlet box wire (usually black) with a plastic wire connector and wrap the connection with electrical tape. DO NOT REVERSE THE HOT AND NEUTRAL CONNECTIONS OTHERWISE SAFETY WILL BE COMPROMISED.
- 14. Tuck these wire connections neatly into the ceiling outlet box.
- 15. Slip canopy (E) to ceiling and secure with canopy ring (F).
- 16. Insert the recommended bulbs into the sockets.
- 17. Restore power to outlet box and check operation of fixture.
- 18. Assembly is complete.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Avoid the use of all polishers, cleaners, and abrasives, as they will damage the finish of your lamp. To remove dust or fingerprints, wipe gently with a soft, clean cloth.
