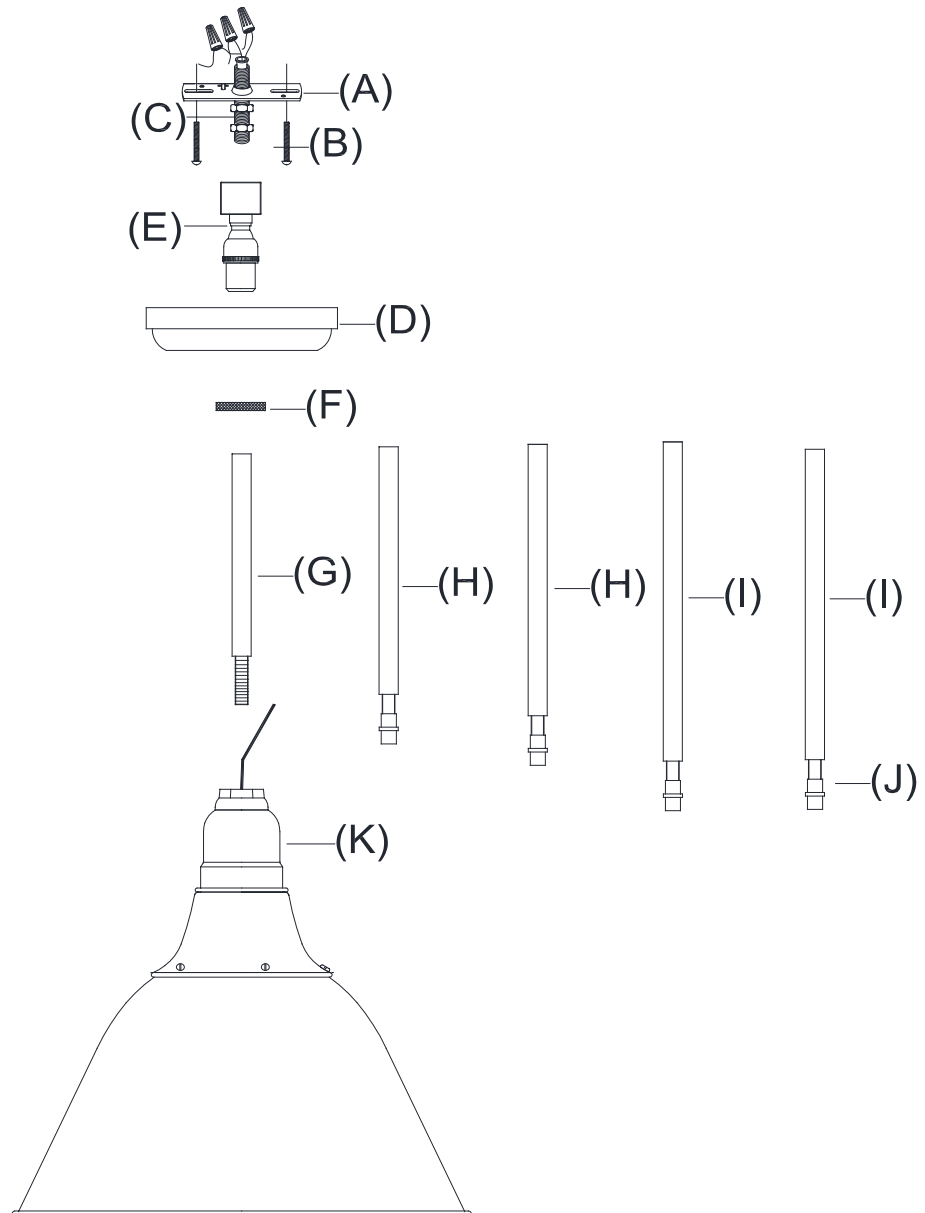

1. Carefully remove all parts from the box and remove all plastic coverings.
2. Determine the hanging length of the fixture. Connect Shade Assembly (K) to some or all Cord Covers (G) (H) (I) and Connectors (J) according to the height needed.
3. Thread Rod (E) onto the inner connection rod of the top Cord Cover (G) (H) (I).
4. Unscrew Canopy Ring (F). Slide Canopy Ring (F) and Canopy (D) over Cord Covers (G) (H) (I).
5. Feed wires through Cord Covers (G) (H) (I), Connectors (J), Canopy (D) and Rod (E).
6. Affix Mounting Strap (A) to the ceiling outlet box with Mounting Screws (B). Insert the top of Threaded Nipple (C) into Mounting Strap (A).
7. Thread Rod (E) to Threaded Nipple (C).
8. Attach fixture grounding wire (clear silver) and house grounding wire to back plate with the green screw. Connect fixture to corresponding house wire with a wire nut. Carefully tuck the wires back into the outlet box. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THE OUTLET BOX IN YOUR HOME BE PROPERLY GROUNDED.
