
# RESTORATION HARDWARE

## ATELIER SCISSOR TASK TABLE LAMP

### PARTS ENCLOSED:

- (A) Swivel
- (B) Housing
- (C) Threaded Tube
- (D) Base
- (E) Loader
- (F) Washer
- (G) Washer
- (H) Nut
- (I) Wrench
- (J) Polarized Plug
- (K) Adjustment Key



#### **IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. These instructions are provided for your safety. It is important that all instructions are read before beginning the fixture assembly.
- This lamp comes with a polarized plug as a feature to reduce the risk of electrical shock. If the plug does not fit into your outlet, contact a licensed electrician.
- 3. NEVER alter the plug in any way.
- 4. Do not insert the plug into the wall outlet until the lamp is fully assembled.

#### TO ASSEMBLE:

- 1. Unpack all parts and place them on a protected work surface.
- 2. Place base (D) over loader (E). Align housing (B) over the center of base (D).
- 3. Insert threaded tube (C) into the holes in base (D) and loader (E). Pull cored taught from below the base to prevent damage to the wire.
- Carefully hold parts together and turn lamp assembly to the side so the bottom of the base is exposed.
- Slide washers (F) and (G) onto threaded tube (C). Thread nut (H) onto threaded tube (C) and tighten using wrench (I).
- 6. Carefully turn lamp assembly back into upright position.
- 7. Insert one 60W maximum, Type A, medium base bulb into the socket.
- 8. To adjust the position of the lamp, loosen adjustment key (K). Once desired placement is reached, tighten adjustment key (K) to secure position. Repeat step for each of the remaining swivels.
- 9. Remove protective plastic from polarized plug (J). Insert polarized plug (J) into wall outlet.

#### **CARE INSTRUCTIONS:**

To clean, wipe gently with a soft dry cloth. Do not use any chemical or abrasive cleaners as they
may damage the finish.
