BONE CONNECTORS FOR PALLADIAN ARCH AND TRELLISES

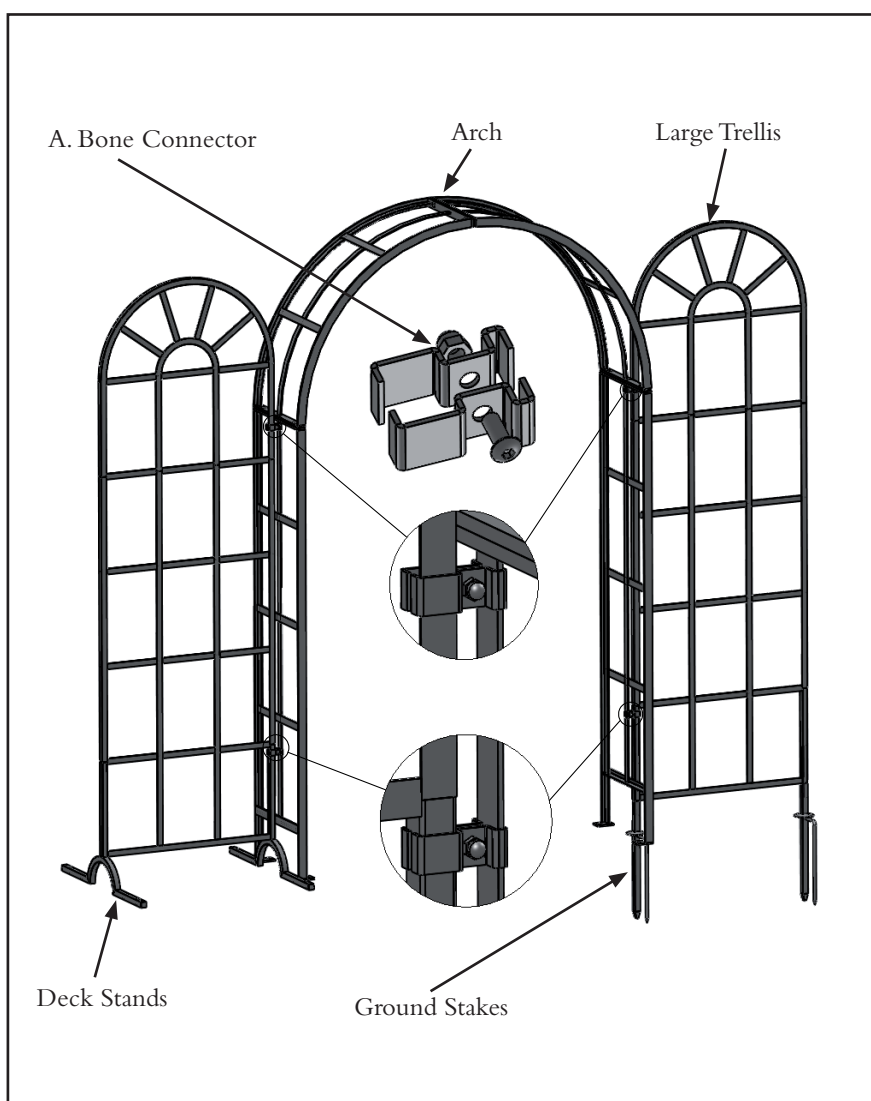
NOTE: BEFORE ASSEMBLY, MAKE SURE YOU HAVE ALL PARTS LISTED BELOW.

Mounting your Palladian Arch and Trellises

1. If you want your Palladian Large Trellis to be connected with Palladian Arch place the Trellis alongside the Arch so that the vertical post of the Trellis is facing the middle vertical post of the Arch.

We recommend that the trellises are standing on the Deck Stands (if mounted on hard ground) or Ground Stakes (if mounted on soft soil).

2. The Trellis should be connected to the Arch with 2 Bone Connectors (A), one at the bottom part and one at the top part (please see the drawing on page 2).

Place the Connectors on the Arch and Trellis and tighten screw with the included Allen and socket wrench.

Caring for your Arch, Trellises and Bone Connectors

This powder-coated steel garden structure is resistant to the effects of sun, rain, frost and snow. It may be left outdoors year-around. To clean, simply wipe with a damp cloth. If the powder finish should chip or scratch, it may be touched up with rust-proof enamel (not included).
