

- 5. Attach cord cover (G) with whole assembly base into bottom of mounting loop (E)
- 6. Unscrew canopy ring (F), slip canopy ring (F) and canopy (D) onto cord cover.
- 7. Attach mounting strap (A) to ceiling outlet box with mounting screws (C) and insert top thread nipple (B) in mounting strap (A).
- 8. Attach mounting loop (E) to thread nipple (B) and tighten the set screw.
