

CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR MODERN DINING TABLES



WALNUT VENEER TABLETOPS

- Do not place hot items directly on the tabletop.
- Use placemats or trivets under hot items and coasters under beverages to prevent marks and stains.
- To avoid scratches, do not place sharp or jagged objects directly on the tabletop.
- Wipe with a soft, damp cloth; avoid the use of harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaning materials.
- Touch-up kits are available for purchase to repair nicks, dents, scratches and cracks on finished wood furniture. These products have been formulated specifically to match the finish color of your furniture. Follow the touch-up kit directions for proper application.



OAK VENEER TABLETOPS

HARDWOOD TABLETOPS

GLASS TABLETOPS

- Do not place hot items directly on the tabletop.
- Clean tabletop with glass cleaner.



MARBLE TABLETOPS

- Marble tabletop is porous and can easily be stained, scratched or chipped.
- Protect from acidic substances like wine, coffee, fruit juice and tomato sauce. Always blot spills immediately and rinse with a clean, damp cloth.
- Do not place hot items directly on the tabletop.
- Do not use chemical cleansers, dusting sprays, abrasive cleaners or furniture polish.
- To prevent ring marks, place coasters or trivets under glasses and dishes; use mats or runners beneath hard objects that might scratch the surface.
- Dust frequently with a clean, soft cloth. Wash periodically with a cloth dampened with warm water, and if necessary, a small amount of mild dishwashing liquid. Use a second damp cloth to remove the soap.



RECLAIMED RUSSIAN OAK TABLES

- Use coasters or placemats to help prevent marks or stains.
- Do not place hot items directly on the tabletop.
- Wipe the table clean with a soft, dry cloth after each use.
- The occasional application of a high-quality clear furniture wax will help protect the finish from minor spills. Please note that slight variations in color and an incomplete seal may occur with any sealant; test on an inconspicuous area first.
