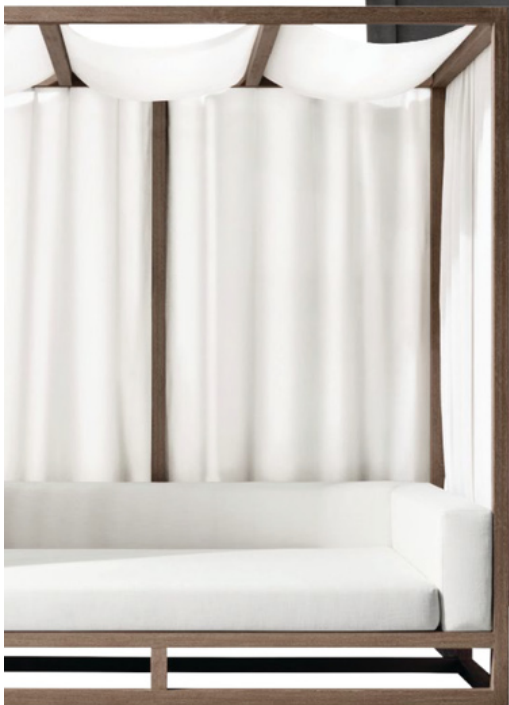

Made from sustainably harvested teak, New York-based Barlas Baylar crafted the crisp, symmetrical outdoor Aviara daybed (from \$6,795, RH, Restoration Hardware)—his first—that's equally organic and refined.



For its first dining bench (bench from \$1,595, table from \$3,595, RH Modern), which is part of The Channel Collection, Thomas Bina and Ed Robinson chose white American oak set on a lustrous metal base.



Twentieth century Venetian designer Mariano Fortuny's graceful silk lighting has been given a contemporary update: carbon fiber, handfinished in gold or silver leaf (\$8,595, RH Modern).



First created by acclaimed midcentury designer Adrian Pearsall in the 1960s, RH Modern's updated version of the sleek Curve sofa (from \$3,395, RH Modern) dons fixed back cushions across a low-slung silhouette.



Los Angeles design duo Lawson-Fenning's elegant Marsden tufted leather chair (\$3,895, RH Modern) was inspired by the geometric sculptures of artist Sol LeWitt.



Bold in black and white, these high contrast outdoor pillows (\$189 each, RH, Restoration Hardware) merge the look and feel of West African mud cloth with high-performance Sunbrella fabric in a subtle slubbed finish.
